

We look forward to your daughter joining the Main School and hope that the information set out below will be of assistance to you. Should you have any concerns your daughter's Form Teacher will be pleased to see you.

Registration

Pupils are required to arrive at school between 8.15 - 8.30 am: registration, in class, is at 8.30 and Assembly at 8.45. In the case of absence it is requested that the school be notified before 10.00 a.m.

Teaching

Throughout the school teaching in classes is differentiated to cater for children's needs.

Sport

If your daughter is unfit for games an 'off games' note is required, please. We ask you to help us avoid problems with lost games kit although we do check it regularly on Monday mornings. So it is essential that all clothes are clearly marked please. Name-tapes should be sewn on the **outside** of shirts, shorts, etc., left chest or left thigh and on the outside of the down turn of games socks. Wellington and trainers should be named on the inside and have initials painted on the outside.

Valuables

Watches, calculators, sports equipment and other valuable items are brought to school entirely at the owner's risk. No jewellery, nor mobile phones, are permitted.

Appearance

Girls should take a pride in their appearance: hair, if below the shoulder, should be tied back with red, grey or navy ribbons or plain bands. No fashion/fancy slides or bands should be worn. Neither gel nor hair colorant is acceptable. Blazers should be worn to and from school.
